SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

A \$4000 first place academic scholarship and a \$2000 second place academic scholarship will be awarded to the high school seniors who:

- Can be certified to be a child of an owner or an employee of an RSA skating center or a child or employee of an RSA affiliated member.
- Completes and timely submits the scholarship application form in its entirety.
- Must have at least a 3.2 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- ACT/SAT scores must be submitted with scholarship application and will be taken into consideration when considering potential scholarship awards.
- Who most exceeds the performance measurement criteria established by the Roller Skating Foundation Board of Directors.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Application should be submitted for the fall semester.
- Applicants must meet the criteria to be considered for this scholarship.
- Completed applications must be received at the Roller Skating Foundation by February 28, 2017.
- Application must be submitted the year in which you plan to attend college.
- Award will be announced in March 2017. Winner will be posted on www.rollerskating.com/scholarships.
